Trojan Profiles: Ruth Fairbank and Ira Hutchison



Ruth Fairbank ('37) - Topeka High's Babe Didrikson! (for those who don't know, Babe Didrikson Zaharias was in the mid 20th century considered America's greatest woman athlete, proficient in many sports). When Miss Fairbank attended THS, the 1930s, girl sports were lim-

ited just to the phys. ed. Department (in the early 1900s there was girls' basketball competition between area schools, but not by 1937). Thus, Ruth Fairbank could only participate in high school as a Trojanette pep club member and with the Girls Athletic Association (G.A.A.) of which she was secretary. A three sport all-star, her first love was baseball (later softball) with a Chesney Park team in 1932 (shortstop). Her local team won a state championship in 1936, and Fairbank continued in the sport with women's teams for the various firms she worked for including the Santa Fe's Freight Claim Dept. But if she weren't out in the field, one could find her on the tennis court or the basketball court (in a national A.A.U. basketball tournament in 1944 she was ranked nationally as the 4th best forward). In later years she took up bowling. When the Topeka Capital-Journal sports dept. compiled a list of the 100 top athletes from Shawnee County, Miss Fairbank was No. 39. She regretted that in her high school days, in basketball, the girls could only play half court, the girls' gym being small. Nevertheless, Ruth Fairbank can be seen as a pioneer for woman's athletics at Topeka High; she passed away in 2017.

In the mid-1940s some activities were still segregated, at THS, notably basketball. Thus, **Ira James Hutchison ('44)** played not for the Black & Gold Trojans (all-white) but instead for the Red & White Ramblers (all-black). After graduation



and with WWII still raging, Hutchison joined the Navy. Upon discharge he entered Kansas State College (Manhattan) graduating in 1950 with a degree in physical education and recreation. Shortly thereafter he obtained a position at the Topeka State Hospital, incorporating recreation in therapy work. Spending 13

years at Topeka State, Hutchison became its recreation director in 1954. In 1965 the Trojan received his Master's degree in therapeutic recreation from Columbia University working in the field in New York City for several years. Next, Hutchison joined the National Park Service (in recreation) becoming it first African-American Deputy Director in 1977. After retirement (1986) he founded the Roundtable Associates, fellow African-Americans in the recreation and conservation fields, to promote more opportunities for minorities. Hutchison saw recreational activities as a vital assistance for those persons recovering from substance abuse. Earning the Interior Department's Distinguished Award, Mr. Hutchison passed away in Silver Spring, MD, in 2011.
