Thank You, Doris Derrington!



Topeka High School look in January after a restoration project returned the foyer to its original charm. Stonework that had been painted yellow a few times, then whitewashed a few more. is now natural again, revealing the warmth its architects envisioned.

This project was funded by a gift from 1951 THS alumnus, Doris Derrington. Doris was a lifelong Topekan, born April 26, 1933. Her parents moved from Rice County to Topeka with the dust bowl. She was their only bundle of joy. Studious and reliable, she graduated from Washburn University in 1955 and worked in Topeka until re-

tiring in 1998. She was honest. She read two unveiled an old school newspapers a day but never worked a crossword puzzle to avoid facing the temptation to cheat. Doris died Feb. 21, 2021. Classmates at her funeral hinted that they weren't strangers to mischief and vice. After all, that era owns the beat generation and conceived the music known now as rock 'n' roll. So, Trojan love or reparations for a misspent youth, Doris funded the project.

> Jeff Morris, project manager for J.F. McGivern Inc., who did the work, said the challenge included finding their best stripping agent to use and adjusting the work schedule from day to night. The process was labor intensive and messy. He said as the project evolved it exposed curiosities such as diary entries from craftsmen of long ago as well as timeless graffiti. The final touch was the application to the stone of a graffiti resistant sealer.



Rosen's Bagels was founded by **Tom Rosen THS 2006,** who went to college in Nashville, lived and went to culinary school in Phoenix, and then started graduate school in Austin in 2013. Tom loved just about everything in Austin, except graduate school and the lack of a quality bagel. With a friend, he started baking bagels and when sampling some of the wares with buddies, they encouraged him to pursue bagels more seriously. In short time, Tom was connected with Matt Wright, owner of Brew and Brew, who then suggested Tom sell some bagels at their coffee shops. In April of 2017, Rosen's started as a pop-up bagel shop every weekend at Brew and Brew and a couple other coffee shops. After consistently selling out, Rosen's Bagel Co. began selling every day. Now, they can be found in over 20 Austin coffee shops and restaurants, in addition to daily catering to homes and offices.

To commemorate this special occasion, current band director, Mrs. Jennifer J. Antonetti, commissioned Kansas composer, Grace Baugher Dunlap to write a piece of music that embodies the spirit of the Topeka High Band program. In planning the new music, Jennifer and Grace discussed the importance of the bell tower and the school song, both of which hold a great significance in connection to the past and continuation in the rich history and traditions of Topeka High. She also included a unique setting of distinct parts for two sets of chimes.
